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## Living Wills – Advance Decisions and Statements

Living Wills, formally known as ‘advance decisions’ allow a person to record their wishes to refuse certain types of medical treatment in case they are unable to make or communicate a decision about treatment in the future. They must be set up when the person still has mental capacity. Advance statements are slightly different from advance decisions and can record any other decisions about how you would like to be treated.

If you have a living will, you may want Hanover staff to be aware of it. Our obligation is limited to advising medical services or family members that the living will exists and wherever possible assisting them to locate and access it.

Where you agree, we will try to ensure that medical staff are made aware of your living will. There may be circumstances where this may not be possible, for example where an estate is not linked to Hanover on Call or where Hanover is not made aware of an emergency. Wherever possible, you should ensure that a friend, neighbour, relative, doctor, solicitor or member of any care team you have also knows about and can locate a copy of your Living Will.

**You should not rely solely on Hanover to ensure that your Living Will is communicated to medical staff. We will not be able to provide any guarantee to third parties that the Living Will is up to date.**
